Quran Syllabus

YEAR 1 - 4

Year 1

- Qaida (Ahsanul Qawaid)
- Arabic letters
- Arabic vowels
- Join letters to read words
- Most students will begin reading Juz 30
- Memorise stage 1 from **Memorisation** Stages
- Understand the key themes of Faatiha and last 22 Surahs (**Tafseer**)

YEAR 2

- Read all of Juz 30 and 29
- Key focus on the pronunciation of letters (Makhaarij)
- Memorise stage 2 from **Memorisation** Stages
- Understand the key themes of Juz 29 30 (**Tafseer**)

YEAR 3 & 4

- Recited the entire Quran by the end of Year 4
- Learn and apply the following Tajweed rules using Madani Qaida:
 - Ikhfa
 - Idgham
 - Ith-har
 - Iqlab
 - Qalqala
 - Maddaat
 - Stopping rules (Wuquf)
- Memorise stage 3 & 4 from Memorisation Stages
- Understand the key themes covered in Juz 25 28 (**Tafseer**)

YEAR 5 & 6

- Recite the entire Quran the second time with accurate application of all Tajweed rules learnt in Year 3 & 4.
- Learn and apply additional Tajweed rules from a traditional Tajweed text "Tuhfa tul Atfal:"
 - Types of Laam
 - Alqaab al Huruf
 - Sifaat al Huruf
 - Rule of Similar Letters
 - Additional Madaat: Madd Iwad, Madd Sila, Tamkeen
 - Awareness of other Qira'aat
- Memorise stage 5 & 6 from **Memorisation** Stages
- Understand the key themes covered in Juz 20 24 (Tafseer)

YEAR 7 - 11

Year 7

- Review of all Tajweed rules learnt in the Madani Qaida and Tufa tul Atfal.
- Review of all memorisation from the first 6 Memorisation Stages
- Understand the key themes covered in Juz 16 19 (**Tafseer**)

Year 8 - 11

- Learn to recite the Quran in the Uthmaani/Madani Script.
- Tuhfa tul atfal in Arabic Tajweed text
- Jazariya in Arabic Tajweed text
- Read the entire Quran in Qira'a Hafs and get Ijaza
- Read the entire Quran in Qira'a Shu'ba and get Ijaza
- Memorise stage 7 11 from **Memorisation** Stages
- Understand the key themes covered in Juz 1 15 (Tafseer)

Year 11 IGCSE Syllabus	This paper has three sections of content and students must study the related passages given in Appendix 5: Passages from the Qur'an and Hadith.		
September-December Section A Exam practice	Section A: The life, teachings and achievements of the Prophet Muhammad Students will be expected to know the historical facts and understand the significance of the Prophet's achievements in the development of Islam.		
January –February Section B Exam practice	Section B: The key beliefs, practices and features of the early Muslim community founded by the Prophet Students will be expected to know the historical facts and understand the significance of the beliefs and practices of the early Muslim community in the development of Islam.		
February- April Section C Exam practice	Section C: Living the Muslim life today Students will be expected to know how Muslims express their religion in their day-to-day lives and understand the obligations placed upon Muslims by their faith.

Arabic Syllabus

We follow the ICO syllabus for Arabic. It includes topics to acquire vocabulary for conversational use and religious topics like: Ayaat of the Quran, Hadith, lives of the companions and important Islamic lessons. The books also cover grammar (Nahw) and morphology (Sarf).

Our syllabus covers the first 7 ICO books, approximately one book per year, over the 7 years of Arabic from Year 5 to Year 11. To further strengthen the foundations of grammar and morphology (Sarf), students will cover an additional book on grammar and one on morphology.

The students will learn the linguistic Tafseer of Juz Amma (30th Juz) in Arabic in Year 10 and 11 alongside the ICO books.
